## Parish plan 2018 -2019 Final consultation

*"We are a community of joyful disciples growing together and sharing Christ's message"*

The parish plan has been developed out of an extensive consultation process open to all parishioners. This has included the amalgamation of our parish into one, and more recently the 2017 Synod process and the Stewardship Day held in November 2017.

We have formulated seven goals, each with a number of actions. We have time-lined the actions over the next two years. These may be developed, changed and added to as we progress. You will find these displayed on a poster at the back of the church, and on the parish website.

We need your feedback. Below are a number of questions which we ask you to consider and respond to. You can do this by emailing the parish office, or through [Survey Monkey](#). Details will follow via the parish website and parish app. Parishioners might also approach a member of the parish council in person to give feedback.

1. Looking at the activities, do you think that they are realistic?
2. Given that we are at the end of the consultation process, is there any 'burning issue' that might have been missed?
3. Thinking about the opportunities to participate through the parish amalgamation, synod and stewardship day processes, rate your satisfaction with the consultation process.
4. Looking at the parish plan, rate your overall satisfaction with the plan.
