

From Fr Cirilo

Dear Parishioners, Peace!

Today is the third Sunday of advent. Gaudete Sunday. Rose colour candle. The Sunday of rejoicing! As we draw closer to the feast of the Nativity, we are called to rejoice, to wait for the one with joy. In this time of pandemic, how do we cry out with joy and gladness? How do we see the one who is great, the saviour?

In the first reading from the prophet Zephanhai, he was the prophet who warned a distressed people about the coming of the Lord. But instead of the warning that caused fear, the coming of the Lord is supposed to give joy. Be glad! Exalt! Oh Zion sing Joyfully! And if I were part of that people, I would say why? Why should we exalt? Why should we be glad? Zephaniah answered, "because the Lord, your God, is in your midst." And because the Lord is in the midst, there is no discouragement. There is no room for fear.

This is not a joy that we can find in our ordinary activity. It is a joy that is rooted in faith. The faith vision that tells us, we might have lost everything, life might continue to be troubled, there will be trials, yet the fundamental truth is there — the Lord is with us. God who knows us will be compassionate and merciful. And Zephaniah adds, the Lord will rejoice with his people. So this is amazing.

Our Gospel comes from St. Luke. Now many people who heard John the Baptist about the coming of the Lord were filled with anticipation. They were filled with hopeful anticipation. Having this message about someone who would come, hearing the invitation for conversion of heart and mind - metanoia, the joy in the coming of the Lord that requires the change of heart.

The people asked John, what should we do? What kind of conversion should we embrace so that our anticipation, our joy, our longing for the one, the anointed of the Lord, would be complete? John the Baptist told the people, everyone start sharing, share the gift, share resources. It will give you joy. The tax collectors asked JB, what should we do? JB told

them straight to their faces, "do not cheat, do not steal, be honest." Look after the common good. Be honest. That will give you joy and fulfilment.

What joy it is to see people living the joy of the Lord. In this time of pandemic, I rejoice to see people bringing joy to others.


