## DECREE

I hereby decree that the territorial area of the former St Joseph's Parish, Mount Victoria, is to be removed from the Catholic Parish of Wellington South and incorporated into St Mary of the Angels Parish (Wellington Central).

In accord with Canon 515 §2, I consulted the Archdiocesan Council of Priests at its meeting on 10 February 2021 about this change in the boundaries of the Catholic Parish of Wellington South and St Mary of the Angels Parish (Wellington Central).

In accord with Canon 121, St Mary of the Angels Parish will acquire the properties which were patrimonial goods of the former St Joseph's Parish, Mt Victoria, and \$59,208.87 in cash, this being the residue of the funds contributed to the Catholic Parish of Wellington South by the former St Joseph's Parish at the time of amalgamation. The amount of \$59,208.87 was agreed by the Finance Committee of the Catholic Parish of Wellington South on 27 May 2021.

Given at Wellington on this 12th day of June 2021, the feast of the Immaculate Heart of Mary.

Notary:

*The area removed from the Catholic Parish of Wellington South and incorporated into St Mary of the Angels Parish comprises:*

- North Taranaki Street Terminal, Wellington Harbour till Point Jerningham*
- East Alexandra Road just north of the former Ewart Hospital and over Mt Victoria tunnel, from the Bus Tunnel western side of Alexandra Road only, western side of Thane Road, across to Grafton Road at junction with the Crescent, all of Maida Vale Road from Evans Bay Parade (border with the previous Kilbirnie Parish, now border with Holy Trinity Parish).*
- South Hankey Street, including Oak Grove, from there north side of and thus excluding: Wallace Street, Finlay, Yale. Drummond Street and Hospital Road; and from there across to Town Belt (Alexandra Park) (border with the former Newtown Parish).*
- West Taranaki Street Terminal, Taranaki Street (both sides) till Vivian Street, both sides of Vivian Street till Willis Street (including Bute Street), east side of Willis Street south of its intersection with Vivian Street, Brooklyn Road from Willis Street to its junction with Nairn Street across from the Renouf Tennis Centre (border with Wellington Central Parish).*
