"I AM THE WAY THE TRUTH AND THE LIFE."

Have you ever set out on a journey and got lost? What happened and how did you feel? We use maps and directions to plan a journey when we travel to a destination we have not visited before. In today's Gospel, Jesus confuses His Disciples when He tells them that they already know the way to a place they have never been to. How could this be? Listen carefully to find out. (John 14:1-12).

Jesus told the disciples that He would soon be leaving them. Where was He going? Jesus points that He is the WAY, the TRUTH and the LIFE. Jesus connects us to the Father as no one else can. Jesus also makes it clear that we should do what He does. Jesus' life is focused on doing the Will of the Father for the good of all Humanity.


As Christ's disciples, we also will find our highest motivation and glory by identifying ourselves with Christ's Obedience in our daily lives, especially by keeping His new commandment of sacrificial unconditional and forgiving love.

The readings of today tell us that "We are called to follow and serve Jesus," even though we don't know where that might lead us. The

first reading tells 'how and why the first deacons were chosen.' Psalm reminds that God 'loves Justice And right.' Second reading, Peter calls the people to be a 'Holy Priesthood.' And in the Gospel, Jesus tells us to 'Have Faith in Him.'

Therefore, every Christian finds strength for the journey in Jesus Christ by; Living a life of prayer, acceptance of suffering, and always having faith and trust in Jesus Christ our Lord and Saviour, believing that we are journeying with Him. "JESUS IS THE WAY, THE TRUTH AND THE LIFE."
