Gospel Reflection

In today's readings Elijah, Paul and Peter are all experiencing some form of torment. Recognising the presence of God is also a common theme in all of the readings.

For Elijah, fleeing from the threat of persecution, God's presence was recognised in the sound of a gentle mountain breeze/whisper and not the mighty wind, thunder, lightning and earthquake.


For Paul, the torment comes from knowing that despite their history, his own people failed to recognise Jesus as the Messiah.

In the Gospel, the disciples fear for their lives in a storm buffeted boat. They are terrified when they see a figure walking across the water towards them. It is only after Jesus



identifies himself and reassures the disciples that their situation improves.

How do we recognise God's presence during the storms in our lives? It may be in a way that we are not expecting. **Shane Connolly**
