Gospel Reflection

Getting to a resolution

In the Gospel, Jesus teaches the disciples how to deal with sin-related conflict. First, individually, then privately, and finally publicly. Why this process?

Dealing with sin the way Jesus tells us to, helps individuals, while protecting the health and wellbeing of our church whānau and communities.

First, we must confront the sin and help those who have sinned. The one who has been hurt must go and speak individually with the one who has sinned to try and work things out and restore the relationship.

Jesus is telling us that it's important to deal with sin otherwise it may grow. He is also telling us to make our relationships with one another right. How we do that is important too. When we meet with the person who has sinned individually, we help provide a space where they can talk more freely, we help preserve their mana and minimise gossip.

If they repent, great! We have helped one of our church whānau or community.

If the person refuses to repent, then the one who was hurt, should return with one or two others as witnesses. When two or three gather in Jesus' name there is great power, and Jesus is amongst them. In this way, we show love to the person who caused the hurt and can pray for them together. Again, if they refuse to repent, then the issue is to be taken to the church or assembly for consideration.

So, when we have disagreements or arguments, deal with the matter individually, then privately, and finally publicly. Know always that God loves and forgive us all - when we agree and disagree.
