

Dear Parishioners,


Forgiveness implies an understanding of our own inner poverty, brokenness and sin, and therefore our need for forgiveness and reconciliation. This enables us to forgive with understanding and humility. To forgive and be willing to admit at times that we may have been at least partly to blame for what happened.

And it is not just good enough to forgive in word. We must forgive, as the Gospel says, from the heart.

It is forgiveness that clears a path for God to forgive us of our own wrongdoings, the only obstacle that we can possibly put in the way of God's forgiveness is our own inability to forgive the wrongs of others. At the beginning of each Eucharist, we are invited to be mindful of our own sins. Only when we do that can we pray sincerely the 'Our Father': 'forgive us our trespasses, as we forgive those who trespass against us.'

Blessed are those who forgive; they shall obtain forgiveness for their own sins.
