From Fr Doug

Dear Parishioners

A great preacher once wrote:

'You cannot fly without wings. You cannot grow without roots. We cannot offer warmth to others if our own fireplace is cold and empty. We can only love with the amount of love that is in us. Whether we are conscious of it or not, we do love others precisely as we love ourselves.'

So, it is very important to have a healthy love and respect for ourselves after all we are God's precious children. This is where love starts within us but of course it is not meant to end there. All true love of self, flows in the form of our love of God and of our love of others. As Jesus tells us love of God is the first commandment and the second commandment love of neighbour as you love vourself.

It is easy to love certain people because they are truly loveable. But not so easy to love certain others who we don't really respect or trust. But that is the test of the love God commands from us. The great preacher again: 'Where there is no love, sow love, and you will reap love. Where there is no love, put love, and you will find love.'

In the middle of the dense forest of rules and regulations — to the legalisms of past and present — Jesus makes an opening through which one can catch a glimpse of two faces: the face of the Father and the face of the brother/sister. He does not give us two formulas or two precepts: there are no precepts nor formulas. He gives us two faces, actually only one real face, that of God reflected in many faces, because in the face of each brother/sister, especially of the smallest, the most fragile, the defenceless and needy, there is God's own image. And we must ask

ourselves: when we meet one of these brothers/ sisters, are we able to recognize the face of God in him/her? Are we able to do this?


