The Ascension marks the end of Jesus' earthly mission. The time has come for Jesus, triumphant over death, to physically leave the disciples and begin a new life with God. One dramatic chapter is ending and a new chapter is beginning.


During the period after Easter, Jesus has appeared to the disciples many times in his post resurrection form. He has greeted and comforted them, explaining the kingdom of God and what has happened in the context of the scriptures. It has all been in preparation for this occasion.

Jesus gives his final instructions to the disciples to go out and proclaim the Good News and promises they will be baptised by the Holy Spirit.

That must have been an exhilarating time for the early Church (if not a little overwhelming!). Like a young adult leaving home and finding their way in the world, the time has come for each disciple to step up and go about their mission.

Today that responsibility to step up and spread the Good News belongs to us. Let us live out Jesus' instruction to the disciples and bring goodness where there is evil and healing where there are wounds.
