Gospel Reflection

Our hearts desire

Today's readings and psalms tell us God's plan for a joy filled, peaceful, fruitful life for all people. A holy nation comes from loving and being in communion with God, and, following his commandments. Imagine a world where everyone fulfils their calling in the work of creation. Wow!

But, we see in the Gospel that the Pharisees and scribes seem to think that good handwashing practices are critical to God's plan? This raises the questions of what is at the heart of God's plan for us in contrast to customs or traditions that may or may not bring people closer to God. Are our actions life giving to all people or self-serving? Do we judge others by what they do or don't do?

Jesus responded to the Pharisees and scribes saying 'People honour me with their lips but their hearts are far from me' and 'You disregard God's commandment but cling to human tradition'. We are all sinners and our hearts cannot be fixed by our own efforts. It is through will and grace that we are made right with God. Let us be willing to accept we need help.

When we truly know the depth and breadth of God's love, follow his commandments, and desire communion with God, then, there will be no room left in our hearts for evil and sin. Nothing that comes from outside will be able to shake us — including poor handwashing practices.

Believe in, and, desire God's constant love with all your heart. Go well, spread God's love and serve one another.
