
Gospel Reflection

Today we celebrate a very momentous event of the Risen Lord, HE is taken into heaven, Ascension Sunday. In the First reading, Jesus promises the apostles that the Holy Spirit will come upon them and will be their guide, empowering them to continue HIS mission of spreading the Gospel to all nations. The apostles asked the Lord if the time had come for the kingdom to be restored to Israel. However, the Lord asked them to be patient as it is God the Father who decides. This reminds us to look inside our hearts if we are patient enough to let the Holy Spirit guide us in our everyday spiritual journey. I feel that the Lord is telling us to be patient too. However, we can't just stand around waiting, looking upwards, like the apostles did when Jesus disappeared. We must get on with our mission of spreading the Good News in whatever way we can.

Furthermore, in the Second reading the Hebrew's encourage us to be confident in God's promise of salvation through Jesus Christ. It provides a powerful prayer for wisdom and knowledge about God's purpose for all of us in the glory of HIS death and resurrection.

As we reflect on the Gospel today, we know that the apostles were living witnesses to HIS ascension and the promise of the Holy Spirit. As followers of Christ, we become witnesses as well as we actively spread the Good News. We pray that we will live with active faith and not a passive one through participation in the Eucharist and devotional prayers and practices, being involved in and contributing to the life of our parish community and living out our Christian values in our simple daily interactions with others.


