

### **Gospel Reflection**

Today we celebrate the feast day of the Solemnity of the Holy Trinity, the feast of our One true God in three Divine Persons; the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit. The Father is the Creator, the Son is the Redeemer and the Holy Spirit is the Sanctifier.

The first Reading, emphasises Wisdom as God's Companion in creation. (Prov.8:22-31). The second emphasises that the Love of God is poured into our hearts. (Rom. 5:1-5). Gospel from St John (16:12 - 15), the Spirit of Truth will lead you to the TRUTH. We share the Love of God, the Goodness of Jesus the Son and the Friendship of the Holy Spirit. The Trinity becomes visible through Love. St Augustine teaches us that the Trinity reveals in Charity-love made manifest. This is the deeper meaning of today's Gospel where St John declares, "God so love the world that He gave His Only begotten Son..." Jesus is the highest and most perfect express of charity, the love of the Father made flesh and made present through the work of the Holy Spirit. The solemnity we celebrate reveals the truest face of God. The Triune God is Merciful, Forgiving and Saving.

The Trinity means that God is a Community. The three Divine Persons are in relationship with each other. Therefore the Trinity lives in a perfect communion of love and understanding. As we strive to live a deep relationship with one another, we enter into a communion of love and this enable us to experience the love that our Father has for us and His intention to draw us that communion of love, that He lives with Jesus and the Holy Spirit. One God and three Persons is a oneness with diversity. Our Parish Community is One with Diversity which means although we are from different cultures, we are one in Faith and Love our belief.

Every Liturgical act of the Church to the simplest personal prayer always begins with the Trinitarian formula, "In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen" The solemnity of the Holy Trinity invites us to contemplate the very heart of God, a Communion of love between the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit. This love is not distant but dynamic and ever-giving. Through creation, redemption and sanctification, God reveals Himself as the Almighty and loving Father, our saving brother and guiding Spirit.

May this feast deepen our awareness of this Divine mystery and inspire us to live in the Image of the Trinity: in love, unity and communion. Let us open our hearts to the outpouring of divine love and strive to reflect that love in our Relationships, Communities and the world. Ask yourself; Am I guided in my life by the grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, the love of God the Father and the communion of the Holy Spirit? Now let us pray together, "Glory be to the Father, and to the Son and to the Holy Spirit. As it was in the beginning, is now and ever shall be, world without end. Amen

During May, the St Francis de Sales community acknowledged the **60**<sup>th</sup> **anniversary** of the laying of the Church's foundation stone by Archbishop Peter McKeefry in 1965. The church in Island Bay has a 'significant' heritage listing with the Wellington City Council, due to

its striking mosaic of Christ on the cross made from 135,000 pieces of ceramic glass, special plastic tiles and innovative coloured window featuring the patron saint, St Francis de Sales.
